A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 5 through 11, 2007, as "Nurses Week"
2 in Pennsylvania.

7 12, Florence Nightingale's birthday; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 5
9 through 11, 2007, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania in
