## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of May 2007 as "National Preservation 2 Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, In 1971 the National Trust for Historic Preservation
- 4 established "Preservation Week" as an opportunity to spotlight
- 5 grass-roots preservation efforts around the country directed at
- 6 saving historic properties for the enjoyment of future
- 7 generations; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Since then the National Trust for Historic
- 9 Preservation has observed the event annually; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "Preservation Week" has grown as an annual
- 11 celebration and is celebrated by small towns and big cities with
- 12 events ranging from tours, reenactments and rallies to black-tie
- 13 balls and state and local competitions; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The success of "Preservation Week" has moved the
- 2 National Trust for Historic Preservation to extend the
- 3 celebration into a monthlong event during May 2007 in order to
- 4 bring the issue of historic preservation to the forefront of
- 5 Americans' daily lives by emphasizing the vital importance of
- 6 protecting our nation's history; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 8 month of May 2007 as "Preservation Month" in Pennsylvania.
