A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of October 2007 as "Fire Prevention Month"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Fire is a serious hazard in our homes and
4 communities; and

5 WHEREAS, Our homes are where we face the greatest risk and
6 the greatest loss from fire; and

7 WHEREAS, The National Fire Protection Association has
8 documented that a significant number of fires occur because
9 people leave the kitchen while they are frying, grilling,
10 broiling or boiling foods; and

1 WHEREAS, Using proper care and turning off the stove whenever
2 leaving the kitchen, even for short periods of time,
3 substantially reduce the threat of fire and the painful injury
4 and property damage associated with residential cooking fires;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, "Practice Your Escape Plan" is the theme for the
7 national observance of "Fire Prevention Week," October 7 through
8 13, 2007; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
10 month of October 2007 as "Fire Prevention Month" in Pennsylvania
11 and call upon the people of this Commonwealth to be aware of all
12 fire risks in their homes and communities.
