13	WHEREAS, A growing number of people in their 30s, 40s and 50s
14	will be diagnosed with early-onset Alzheimer's disease; and

WHEREAS, The Alzheimer's Association is the first and largest
voluntary health organization dedicated to finding prevention
methods, treatments and an eventual cure for Alzheimer's
disease, and it provides support for all those affected by this
disease; and
