A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the observance of "International Day for the
- Elimination of Racial Discrimination on March 21, 2008, and
- 3 embracing the goal of the United Nations.
- 4 WHEREAS, On March 21, 1960, police opened fire and killed 69
- 5 people at a peaceful demonstration against apartheid in
- 6 Sharpeville, South Africa; and
- WHEREAS, In 1966, the United Nations proclaimed that March 21
- 8 would henceforth be observed as "International Day for the
- 9 Elimination of Racial Discrimination"; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The United Nations calls upon all nations to
- 11 redouble their efforts to eliminate all forms of racial
- 12 discrimination, this day and always; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 14 observance of March 21, 2008, as "International Day for the
- 15 Elimination of Racial Discrimination" and embrace its goal
- 16 within this Commonwealth.
