## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 11 through 17, 2008, as "National  
2 Police Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Approximately 702 police officers have made the  
4 ultimate sacrifice since the beginning of law enforcement within  
5 this Commonwealth by being killed in the line of duty; and

6 WHEREAS, Across the United States the week of May 11 through  
7 17, 2008, will be recognized as "National Police Week"; and

8 WHEREAS, The first National Police Officers' Memorial Day was  
9 held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by  
10 President John F. Kennedy, on October 1, 1962, and has continued

1 to be observed annually in memory of those police officers who  
2 made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; therefore be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the memory  
4 of the hundreds of police officers who gave their lives in the  
5 line of duty in this Commonwealth; and be it further

6       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
7 week of May 11 through 17, 2008, as "National Police Week" in  
8 Pennsylvania.
