AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
- 3 carrying a false identification card.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6310.3 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 6310.3. Carrying a false identification card.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (f) Confiscation. -- Any person authorized to sell liquor or
- 11 malt or brewed beverages under the act of April 12, 1951
- 12 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, or an agent, employee
- 13 or representative of the person, shall confiscate an
- 14 identification card that has been presented for the purposes of
- 15 <u>obtaining liquor or malt or brewed beverages when there is a</u>
- 16 reasonable suspicion that a person has presented an
- 17 identification card as described in subsection (a). The
- 18 identification card confiscated under this subsection shall be

- submitted to law enforcement personnel to make a determination 1
- 2 of the validity of the identification card presented. The
- 3 confiscation shall not impose civil or criminal liability upon
- 4 <u>an individual confiscating the identification card.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
