AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 selection of prospective jurors.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4521(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4521. Selection of prospective jurors.
- 9 (a) Preparation of master list of prospective jurors.--
- 10 (1) At least annually the jury selection commission
- 11 shall prepare a master list of prospective jurors[.] that
- 12 shall contain the most recent available address for
- 13 prospective jurors.
- 14 (2) The list shall <u>also</u> contain all voter registration
- lists for the county, which lists may be incorporated by
- 16 reference, or names from such other lists which in the
- opinion of the commission will provide a number of names of

- 1 prospective jurors which is equal to or greater than the
- 2 number of names contained in the voter registration list.
- 3 (3) The commission may, but will not be required to,
- 4 supplement the master list of prospective jurors to include,
- 5 without being limited to, persons in any of the following
- 6 categories:
- 7 [(1)] <u>(i)</u> Persons listed in telephone, city, municipal
- 8 directories and similar directories.
- 9 [(2) Persons who pay taxes or are assessed for taxes
- imposed by any political subdivisions.
- 11 (3)] (ii) Persons in the county participating in any
- 12 State, county or local program authorized by law and, to the
- extent such names are available, persons participating in any
- 14 Federal program authorized by law.
- 15 [(4)] <u>(iii)</u> Persons who are on school census lists.
- [(5)] <u>(iv)</u> Any other person whose name does not appear
- in the master list of prospective jurors and who meets the
- qualifications for jurors set forth in this chapter and who
- 19 makes application to the commission to be listed on the
- 20 master list of prospective jurors.
- 21 <u>(v) Persons who appear on the list provided to the</u>
- 22 county pursuant to section 4521.1 (relating to Statewide
- 23 jury information system) may be used to supplement or
- 24 <u>substitute the master jury list.</u>

- 26 Section 2. Title 42 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 27 § 4521.1. Statewide jury information system.
- 28 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any prohibition found in
- 29 any other law, regulation or rule to the contrary, the following
- 30 <u>departments shall submit to the Court Administrator of</u>

- 1 Pennsylvania, in a format provided herein, a list of individuals
- 2 as designated for that department to be included in a Statewide
- 3 jury information system on or before June 30 OCTOBER 31 of each
- 4 <u>year:</u>
- 5 (1) The Department of Public Welfare every individual
- 6 resident in this Commonwealth who receives cash assistance or
- 7 food stamps pursuant to a Federal or State program through
- 8 the department except as prohibited by Federal law or
- 9 <u>regulation</u>.
- 10 (2) The Department of Transportation every individual
- resident in this Commonwealth who has been issued a driver's
- 12 <u>license pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S Ch. 15 (relating to licensing</u>
- of drivers).
- 14 (3) The Department of Revenue every individual
- resident who files a return for the payment of taxes imposed
- by the Commonwealth under Article III of the act of March 4,
- 17 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971.
- 18 (4) The Department of State every individual resident
- 19 who is listed as a registered voter under 25 Pa.C.S. Pt. IV
- 20 <u>(relating to voter registration).</u>
- 21 (b) Identifying information. -- Each list submitted by a
- 22 department pursuant to subsection (a) shall contain only the

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- 23 following identifying information, IF AVAILABLE, of an
- 24 individual to be included in the Statewide jury information
- 25 <u>system:</u>
- 26 (1) Name, including first, middle and last names,
- 27 INCLUDING ANY SUFFIXES.
- 28 (2) Except as provided in 23 Pa.C.S. Ch. 67 (relating to
- 29 <u>domestic and sexual violence victim address confidentiality)</u>,
- 30 each individual's street address, municipality and zip code.

1	(3) Date of birth, if available.	<-
2	(4) The last four digits of the individual's Social	
3	Security number.	
4	(c) Duties of Court Administrator The Court Administrator	
5	shall annually collect information for creation of a Statewide	
6	jury information system. This shall be completed by:	
7	(1) Collecting the names from the departments as	
8	submitted under subsection (a).	
9	(2) Combining each individual department list submitted	
10	into a master list.	
11	(3) Removing any information that identifies the source	
12	of the information submitted pursuant to subsection (a).	
13	(4) Assembling the names into groups arranged by the	
14	county of residence for each individual on the master list.	
15	(5) Removing duplicate names from each county list.	
16	(d) Dissemination Upon request from the jury selection	
17	commission of the county, the Court Administrator shall make	
18	available to the requesting county the list of names for that	
19	county from the Statewide jury information system. In providing	
20	the information, the Court Administrator shall only provide the	
21	name and address, ADDRESS AND DATE OF BIRTH of each individual	<-
22	on the list being provided. All other identifying information	
23	shall be removed from any list made available pursuant to the	
24	request. Under no circumstances may the Court Administrator	
25	include any other identifying information.	
26	(e) Restrictions on use of information Information	
27	provided by the departments to the Court Administrator shall be	
28	provided by agreement executed by the appropriate authorities.	
29	The agreement shall include, but not be limited to, the	
30	following conditions:	

Τ	(1) Information required pursuant to this section will	
2	be provided only in an electronic form as determined by the	
3	Court Administrator.	
4	(2) The information provided shall be used only for the	
5	purpose provided in this section and for no other purpose.	
6	(3) Except for the purpose of internal review and	
7	compliance by the Court Administrator, no lists may be	
8	printed from the information submitted, created or produced	
9	under this section.	
10	(4) Any EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 4521(B) (RELATING	<
11	TO SELECTION OF PROSPECTIVE JURORS), ANY re-release of the	
12	information provided pursuant to this section is strictly	
13	prohibited.	
14	(5) The Statewide jury information system and any list	
15	provided by the Court Administrator to the county jury	
16	selection commission pursuant to this section may not reveal	
17	the source of names on that list or indicate in any way the	
18	source of the names submitted pursuant to subsection (a).	
19	(6) Nothing EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 4521(B),	<
20	NOTHING submitted, created or produced under this section	
21	shall constitute a public document nor shall it be subject to	
22	release or disclosure under the act of June 21, 1957	
23	(P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the Right-to-Know Law or	
24	any other similar rule, enactment or decision.	
25	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
