AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, requiring sellers of cellular phones  
3 to keep a record of each sale.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 7331. Records of cellular phone sales.

9 (a) Requirement.--Any person who sells a cellular phone  
10 shall require the purchaser to provide photo identification with  
11 a home address and shall keep a record of the name and address  
12 of the purchaser and a photocopy of the person's photo  
13 identification for a period of at least one year from the date  
14 of the sale.

15 (b) Penalty.--Any person who violates subsection (a) commits  
16 a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to  
17 pay a fine of \$100.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
