9	(a) Offense definedA person commits an offense if that
10	person knowingly, with the intent to harass, annoy or alarm,
11	shines a laser pointer at another person.
12	(b) Grading
13	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), an offense
14	under subsection (a) is a summary offense.
15	(2) If the offense in subsection (a) is committed
16	against a person operating a motor vehicle, the offense shall
17	be a misdemeanor of the third degree.
18	(c) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "laser

- 1 pointer" means a handheld device that emits a laser beam.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
