16	(4) "Unfair methods of competition" and "unfair or deceptive

19	(xx.1) Contracting with a purchaser for an alteration or

1	modification to a motor vehicle, including tinting the windows
2	of a motor vehicle, that will cause the motor vehicle to violate
3	State motor vehicle safety inspection laws and regulations and
4	failing to inform the purchaser that the alteration or
5	modification will cause such violation.

7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
