6	Section 1. Section 3805(a) and (c) of Title 75 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
8	§ 3805. Ignition interlock.
9	(a) General ruleIf a person violates section 3802
10	(relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled
11	substance) and[, within the past ten years, has a prior offense
12	as defined in section 3806(a) (relating to prior offenses) or
13	has had their operating privileges suspended pursuant to section
14	1547(b.1) (relating to chemical testing to determine amount of
15	alcohol or controlled substance) or 3808(c) (relating to
16	illegally operating a motor vehicle not equipped with ignition
17	interlock) and the person] seeks a restoration of operating
18	privileges, the department shall require as a condition of

1 issuing a restricted license pursuant to this section that the 2 following occur:

3 (1) Each motor vehicle owned by the person or registered 4 to the person has been equipped with an ignition interlock 5 system and remains so for the duration of the restricted 6 license period.

7 (2) If there are no motor vehicles owned by the person 8 or registered to the person that the person so certify to the 9 department. A person so certifying shall be deemed to have 10 satisfied the requirement that all motor vehicles owned by 11 the person or registered to the person be equipped with an 12 ignition interlock system as required by this subsection. 13 \* \* \*

14 (c) Issuance of unrestricted license.--[One year]

15 (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), six months from 16 the date of issuance of an ignition interlock restricted 17 license under this section, if otherwise eligible, a person 18 may be issued a replacement license under section 1951(d) 19 that does not contain the ignition interlock system 20 restriction.

21 (2) If a person violates section 3802 and, within the past ten years, has a prior offense as defined in section 22 23 3806(a) (relating to prior offenses) and the person seeks 24 restoration of operating privileges under this section, the 25 department may not issue a replacement license under section 1951(d) for one year from the date of issuance of an ignition 26 27 interlock restricted license under this section, unless the 28 replacement license contains the ignition interlock 29 restriction.
