AN ACT

Requiring the posting of certain State salary information on the Internet.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Short title.
This act shall be known and may be cited as the State Salary
Information Act.
Section 2. Online posting of salaries.
The State Treasurer shall post on an official Internet website, and update on a monthly basis, the following information concerning the officers and employees described in section 3 :
(1) Name.
(2) Title.
(3) Agency, department or other institution.
(4) Annual salary rate or other rate of compensation.
(5) Supplemental payments other than payments for unused
vacation or unused sick leave. Section 3. Applicability.
(a) General rule.--The provisions of section 2 shall apply to all officers and employees of the Commonwealth, whether of the Executive, Legislative or Judicial branch of the government.
(b) Legislative employees.--For each officer or employee of the Senate and the House of Representatives, in addition to the information required by section 2 , the State Treasurer shall separately indicate whether the officer or employee is paid with funds controlled by the majority caucus, funds controlled by the minority caucus or funds appropriated to compensate the staff of the officers elected by the Senate or the House of

Representatives.
Section 4. Effective date.
This act shall take effect July 1, 2007 , or immediately, whichever is later.
