AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 8, 1957 (P.L.569, No.317), entitled "An
2 act providing compensation to certain persons who served in
3 the military, naval or air forces of the United States or of
4 any of her allies during the Korean Conflict; providing the
5 method of making payment to representatives of persons who,
6 because of death or incapacity, cannot personally receive
7 compensation; imposing certain duties on the Adjutant
8 General; making an appropriation and providing penalties,"
9 extending the time period for filing applications for
10 compensation.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of July 8, 1957 (P.L.569,
14 No.317), known as the Korean Conflict Veterans' Compensation
15 Act, amended September 1, 1965 (P.L.434, No.219), is amended to
16 read:

17 Section 5. Application for Compensation.--Applications for
18 compensation shall be made to the Adjutant General on forms and
19 in the manner as he shall prescribe.

20 Applicants shall state on their application whether or not
21 they have applied for, or received, a bonus, gratuity or

1 compensation of a nature similar to that provided for by this
2 act from any other state in the Union or any allies of the
3 United States.

4 All applications shall be made (1) personally by the veteran,
5 or (2) in case of death or mental incompetency preventing the
6 making of a personal application, then by such representative of
7 the veteran as the Adjutant General shall by regulation
8 prescribe. An application made by a representative other than
9 one authorized by such regulation shall be held void.

10 The Adjutant General shall not accept or consider any
11 application filed or mailed after December 31, [1966.] 2011.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
