17	Section 1. The definition of "low-income adult" in section
18	1302 of the act of June 26, 2001 (P.L.755, No.77), known as the
19	Tobacco Settlement Act, is amended to read:
20	Section 1302. Definitions.
21	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
22	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
23	context clearly indicates otherwise:

1 "Low-income adult." An individual who is at least 19 years
2 of age but less than 65 years of age and whose household income
3 is less than [200%] <u>100%</u> of the Federal poverty level at the
4 time of eligibility determination.
