AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," further providing for maximum ratio of
12 compensation for district election officers.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 412.2(a) of the act of June 3, 1937
16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
17 amended May 12, 2006 (P.L.178, No.45), is amended to read:

18 Section 412.2. Compensation of District Election Officers.--

19 (a) In all counties regardless of class, the compensation of
20 judges of election, inspectors of election, clerks and machine
21 operators shall be fixed by the county board of elections for
22 each election in accordance with the following:

3	Judges of election	\$75	[\$200] <u>\$250</u>
4	Inspectors of election	\$75	[\$195] <u>\$245</u>

7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
