- 10 African, Asian, German, Irish, Puerto Rican, Scandinavian and
- 11 Japanese descent, and 10 to 17 times more African Americans than
- 12 White Americans are afflicted; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Under medical supervision, sarcoidosis can be
- 14 monitored and controlled, but it affects many organs of the body
- 15 and can cause death; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In memory of Kenneth G. (Glen) Dixon, Sr., and to
- 17 raise awareness of sarcoidosis, the Heart of Gold Foundation is
- 18 sponsoring the Walk-Run for Sarcoidosis, themed "Let's Find a
