AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of July 9, 1987 (P.L.220, No.39), entitled "An
- act licensing and regulating the practice of social work;
- providing penalties; and making an appropriation," further
- 4 providing for unlawful practice.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 20(a.1) of the act of July 9, 1987
- 8 (P.L.220, No.39), known as the Social Workers, Marriage and
- 9 Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act, added July 9,
- 10 2008 (P.L.929, No.68), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 20. Unlawful practice.
- 12 * * *
- 13 (a.1) Title.--It shall be unlawful for an individual to hold
- 14 oneself out as a social worker, use the title of "social worker"
- 15 or use the abbreviation of "S.W." without meeting the definition
- 16 of "social worker." This subsection includes advertising as a
- 17 social worker and adopting or using any title or description of
- 18 services incorporating the term "social worker" and their
- 19 related abbreviations, which implies directly or indirectly that

- 1 the individual is a social worker. This subsection shall not
- 2 apply to the following individuals:
- 3 (1) An individual employed by the Commonwealth in a
- 4 social work position on the effective date of this
- 5 subsection, during the time of employment by the
- 6 Commonwealth.
- 7 (2) An individual employed as a school social worker in
- 8 a public or private school in this Commonwealth on or before
- 9 the effective date of this subsection, during the time of
- 10 employment as a school social worker.
- 11 (3) In order to assure compliance with the provisions of
- 12 <u>42 CFR 483.15(g) (relating to quality of life) and 28 Pa.</u>
- 13 Code §§ 201.3 (relating to definitions) and 211.16 (relating
- to social services), an individual employed in a long-term
- care facility licensed by the Department of Health who
- 16 provides social work services under administrative
- 17 supervision.

- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
