- 12 SECTION 1522.1. WORLD LANGUAGE PROGRAM. -- THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 13 EDUCATION SHALL DEVELOP A PROGRAM FOR TEACHING WORLD LANGUAGES
- 14 THROUGHOUT THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY CURRICULA. THE
- 15 DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH STATE STANDARDS FOR THE WORLD
