AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to dogs, regulating 2 the keeping of dogs; providing for the licensing of dogs and 3 kennels; providing for the protection of dogs and the detention and destruction of dogs in certain cases; 5 regulating the sale and transportation of dogs; declaring dogs to be personal property and the subject of theft; 7 providing for the abandonment of animals; providing for the 8 assessment of damages done to animals; providing for payment 9 of damages by the Commonwealth in certain cases and the 10 liability of the owner or keeper of dogs for such damages; 11 imposing powers and duties on certain State and local 12 officers and employees; providing penalties; and creating a 13 Dog Law Restricted Account," further providing for 14 15 construction of article relating to dangerous dogs. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. Section 507-A(c) of the act of December 7, 1982 19 (P.L.784, No.225), known as the Dog Law, added May 31, 1990 20 (P.L.213, No.46), is amended to read: 21 Section 507-A.  - (c) Local ordinances. -- [Those provisions of local ordinances

- 1 relating to dangerous dogs are hereby abrogated.] A local
- 2 ordinance otherwise dealing with dogs may not prohibit or
- 3 otherwise limit a specific breed of dog. This act shall not
- 4 preclude the adoption of any local ordinance applicable to
- 5 <u>dangerous dogs provided that the local ordinance maintains all</u>
- 6 provisions set forth in this act and further provided that a
- 7 <u>local ordinance dealing with dogs may not prohibit or otherwise</u>
- 8 <u>limit a specific breed of dog.</u>

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
