AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in penalties and disposition of fines, further  
3 providing for subsequent convictions of certain offenses.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6503(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 6503. Subsequent convictions of certain offenses.

9 (a) General offenses.--Every person convicted of a second or  
10 subsequent violation of any of the following provisions shall be  
11 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than  
12 \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than six months, or both:

13 Section 1543(a) (relating to driving while operating  
14 privilege is suspended or revoked) except as set forth in  
15 subsection (a.1).

16 Section 3367 (relating to racing on highways).

17 [Section 3733 (relating to fleeing or attempting to elude

1 police officer).]

2 Section 3734 (relating to driving without lights to avoid  
3 identification or arrest).

4 Section 3748 (relating to false reports).

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
