- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of
- invasion of privacy.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7507.1(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended, SUBSECTION (E) IS AMENDED BY
- 8 ADDING A DEFINITION and the section is amended by adding a
- 9 subsection to read:
- 10 § 7507.1. Invasion of privacy.

- 12 (b) Grading.--Invasion of privacy is a misdemeanor of the
- 13 second degree if there is more than one violation or if the
- 14 <u>victim is a minor</u>. Otherwise, a violation of this section is a
- 15 misdemeanor of the third degree.
- 16 (b.1) Mistake as to age. -- It is no defense to prosecution

- 1 under this section that the defendant did not know the age of
- 2 the child. Neither a misrepresentation of age by the child nor a
- 3 bona fide belief that the person is over the specified age shall
- 4 <u>be a defense.</u>
