## HOUSE BILL No. 1710 Session of 2009

## INTRODUCED BY D. EVANS, JUNE 15, 2009

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, JUNE 15, 2009

## A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of November 30, 1965 (P.L.843, No.355), entitled "An 1 act providing for the establishment and operation of Temple 2 University as an instrumentality of the Commonwealth to serve 3 as a State-related university in the higher education system 4 of the Commonwealth; providing for change of name; providing 5 for the composition of the board of trustees; terms of 6 trustees, and the power and duties of such trustees; 7 providing for preference to Pennsylvania residents in 8 tuition; providing for public support and capital 9 improvements; authorizing appropriations in amounts to be 10 fixed annually by the General Assembly; providing for the 11 auditing of accounts of expenditures from said 12 13 appropriations; authorizing the issuance of bonds exempt from taxation within the Commonwealth; requiring the President to 14 make an annual report of the operations of Temple 15 16 University," making Federal and State appropriations for 17 carrying the same into effect; providing for a basis for payments of such appropriations; and providing a method of 18 accounting for the funds appropriated and for certain fiscal 19 information disclosure. 20 21 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 22 hereby enacts as follows:

23 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be

24 necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of Temple

25 University for the fiscal year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010,

26 for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

12 Section 2. Payments to Temple University on account of the 13 appropriation in section 1 shall be made on the basis of costs 14 during the fiscal year.

Section 3. (a) Subject to the requirements of subsection (c), payment to Temple University of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be made monthly during the fiscal year.

(b) Such monthly payments shall be made in accordance with the provisions of section 2 on the basis of estimated costs. The estimate of costs shall be submitted by Temple University to the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and the State Treasurer not later than 30 days prior to the date on which such payment is to be made.

(c) No funds appropriated under this act shall be received by Temple University unless the university agrees to enter into articulation agreements with the community colleges and the State System of Higher Education institutions pursuant to Article XX-C of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, and agrees to participate in a longitudinal data system operated by the Commonwealth

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consistent with any applicable United States Department of
Education guidelines. Failure to implement agreements and
participate in the longitudinal data system for the 2010-2011
school year shall result in the university returning to the
Commonwealth payments received under this act.

6 Section 4. (a) Temple University shall apply the moneys 7 appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted 8 in this act and shall at all times maintain proper records showing the application of such moneys. Not later than 120 days 9 10 after the close of the fiscal year to which this act relates, 11 Temple University shall file, with the Secretary of Education, 12 the General Assembly and the Auditor General of the 13 Commonwealth, a statement setting forth the amounts and purposes 14 of all expenditures made from moneys appropriated by this act 15 and other university accounts during said fiscal year, as 16 provided in section 2, used as a basis for receipt of any 17 appropriation during said fiscal year.

18 (b) Such statement of expenditures and costs shall be 19 reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by 20 21 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered 22 23 and paid by Temple University to the State Treasurer. In respect 24 to expenditures made by the university from moneys other than 25 those appropriated by this act, the Auditor General shall have 26 the right to review only, and he shall file annually with the General Assembly such information concerning said expenditures 27 28 as the General Assembly or any of its committees may require. 29 Section 5. Temple University shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be required by the Department of 30

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Education or the chairman or the minority chairman of the
Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the
minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House
of Representatives.

5 Section 6. Temple University shall present and report its financial statements required under the provisions of this act 6 7 in accordance with: the generally accepted accounting principles 8 as prescribed by the National Association of College and University Business Officers, the American Institute of 9 10 Certified Public Accountants, or their successors, or by any other recognized authoritative body; the "Commonwealth of 11 12 Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher 13 Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related 14 Colleges and Universities"; and the financial reporting policies 15 and standards promulgated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 and by the Federal Government that apply to Temple University. 17 Section 7. Temple University shall make all articulation 18 agreements with other higher education institutions available on 19 the Internet.

20 Section 8. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, or 21 immediately, whichever is later.

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
