30 § 4979.1. Permit for movement of bulk refined oil.	
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1 An annual permit may be issued authorizing the movement on 2 specified highways of refined oil in bulk between a refinery and 3 a distribution facility which exceeds the maximum vehicle gross weight specified in Subchapter C (relating to maximum weights of 4 vehicles). Permits issued under this section shall not exceed a 5 distance of [50] 125 miles. The weight of any vehicle permitted 6 7 under this section may not exceed 107,000 pounds overall gross 8 weight and shall have the following maximum axle weight limits 9 for all nonsteering axles: 10 Single axle 21,000 pounds

11	Tandem axles	42,000 pounds
12	Tridem axles	53,000 pounds
13	Quad axles	63,000 pounds

14 No permit may be issued for this type of movement upon an 15 interstate highway.

16 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:

17 <u>§ 4979.5.</u> Permit for movement of nonhazardous liquid glue.

18 <u>An annual permit may be issued authorizing the movement on</u>

19 specified highways of nonhazardous liquid glue in bulk between a

20 chemical plant and a particleboard or fiberboard manufacturing

21 facility which exceeds the maximum vehicle gross weight

22 specified in Subchapter C (relating to maximum wights of

23 vehicles). Permits issued under this section shall not exceed a

24 distance of 75 miles. The weight of any vehicle permitted under

25 this section may not exceed 105,000 pounds overall gross weight

26 and shall have the following maximum axle weight limits for all

27 <u>nonsteering axles:</u>

28	<u>Single axle</u>	<u>21,000 pounds</u>
29	<u>Tandem axles</u>	<u>42,000 pounds</u>
30	<u>Tridem axles</u>	<u>53,000 pounds</u>

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1 <u>Quad axles</u>

<u>63,000 pounds</u>

- 2 No permit may be issued for this type of movement upon an
- 3 <u>interstate highway.</u>
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
