- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, IN FEES, FURTHER PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL HAULING PERMITS; in size, weight and load, further providing for conditions of permits and security for damages and for permit for movement of bulk refined oil; and providing for permit 5 for movement of nonhazardous liquid glue. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. - 24 weight specified in Subchapter C (relating to maximum weights of
- 25 vehicles). Permits issued under this section shall not exceed a
- 26 distance of [50] 125 miles. The weight of any vehicle permitted
- 27 under this section may not exceed 107,000 pounds overall gross
- 28 weight and shall have the following maximum axle weight limits
- 29 for all nonsteering axles:
- 30 Single axle 21,000 pounds

9	An annual permit may be	issued authorizing the movement on
10	specified highways of nonhazardous liquid glue in bulk between a	
11	chemical plant and a particleboard or fiberboard manufacturing	
12	facility which exceeds the maximum vehicle gross weight	
13	specified in Subchapter C (relating to maximum weights of	
14	vehicles). Permits issued under this section shall not exceed a	
15	distance of 75 miles. The weight of any vehicle permitted under	
16	this section may not exceed 105,000 pounds overall gross weight	
17	and shall have the following maximum axle weight limits for all	
18	<pre>nonsteering axles:</pre>	
19	Single axle	21,000 pounds
20	<u>Tandem axles</u>	42,000 pounds
21	<u>Tridem axles</u>	53,000 pounds
22	<u>Quad axles</u>	63,000 pounds
