## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the 2 offense of aggravated assault. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 2702(a)(5) of Title 18 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 2702. Aggravated assault. 9 Offense defined. -- A person is guilty of aggravated 10 assault if he: 11 12 attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly 13 causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board 14 member or other employee, including a student employee, of 15 any elementary or secondary publicly-funded educational 16 institution, any elementary or secondary private school

licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
