AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for accidents involving death or
- 3 personal injury.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3742(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.
- 9 (a) General rule.--
- 10 (1) The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident
- 11 resulting in injury or death of any person shall immediately
- 12 stop the vehicle at the scene of the accident or as close
- 13 thereto as possible but shall then forthwith return to and in
- every event shall remain at the scene of the accident until
- 15 he has fulfilled the requirements of section 3744 (relating
- to duty to give information and render aid). Every stop shall
- 17 be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

- 1 (2) An occupant of any vehicle involved in an accident
- 2 resulting in injury or death of any person shall, upon
- 3 <u>failure of the driver of the vehicle to comply with the</u>
- 4 requirements of paragraph (1), report the accident as soon as
- 5 the occupant is physically able to the nearest office of an
- 6 <u>authorized police department.</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
