## AN ACT

Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated statutes, providing for mailings by of Genexal Asembly CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICIALS.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 1103. Restricted activities. * * *
(k) Mailings by members of Genexal Assembly CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICIALS. - - No reimbursement or expenditure may be made out of any appropriation account for a mass mailing, including a bulk rate mailing, made at the direction or on behalf of a member of the General Assembly, THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR,

ATTORNEY GENERAL, AUDITOR GENERAL OR STATE TREASURER that is mailed or delivered to a postal facility within 60 days immediately preceding any primary or general election at which

Section 2. Section $1109(\mathrm{~b})$ of Title 65 is amended to read: § 1109. Penalties.

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(b) Financial interests statement violation.--Any person who violates the provisions of section $1103(d)$ through [(j)] (k), 1104 (relating to statement of financial interests required to be filed) or $1105(a)$ (relating to statement of financial interests) commits a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than $\$ 1,000$ or to imprisonment for not more than one year, or both. * * *

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
