## AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the restricted revenue accounts  
2 within the State Gaming Fund and from the State Gaming Fund  
3 to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, the Department of  
4 Revenue, the Pennsylvania State Police and the Attorney  
5 General for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, to June  
6 30, 2011, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining  
7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

## 11 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

12 Section 101. Short title.--This act shall be known and may  
13 be cited as the Gaming Control Appropriation Act of 2010.

## 15 STATE GAMING CONTROL

## 16 RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNTS

17 Section 301. State Gaming Fund.--The following amounts set  
18 forth in this part, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are  
19 hereby appropriated from the State Gaming Fund restricted  
20 revenue accounts under 4 Pa.C.S. § 1401 (relating to slot

1 machine licensee deposits) to the agencies of the Executive  
2 Department named in this part for the purposes set forth for the  
3 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, and for the payment of bills  
4 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year  
5 ending June 30, 2011.

6 Section 302. Attorney General.--The following  
7 amounts are appropriated to the Attorney General:

8 For salaries, wages and all necessary expenses  
9 of the Attorney General related to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt.  
10 II (relating to gaming).

11 State appropriation..... 994,000

12 Section 303. Department of Revenue.--The  
13 following amounts are appropriated to the  
14 Department of Revenue:

15 For the salaries, wages and all necessary  
16 expenses of the Department of Revenue related to 4  
17 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming).

18 State appropriation..... 9,942,000

19 Section 304. Pennsylvania State Police.--The  
20 following amounts are appropriated to the  
21 Pennsylvania State Police:

22 For the salaries, wages and all necessary  
23 expenses of the Pennsylvania State Police related  
24 to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming).

27 Section 305. Pennsylvania Gaming Control  
28 Board.--The following amounts are appropriated to  
29 the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board:

30 For the salaries, wages and all necessary

1 expenses for the proper operation and  
2 administration of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control  
3 Board. This appropriation includes \$8,113,000 from  
4 the restricted revenue account established in the  
5 State Gaming Fund for fees and other revenues  
6 collected by the board.

9 PART V

10 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

11 Section 501. Transfers prohibited.--There is no authority  
12 for the State Treasurer, the Secretary of the Budget, the  
13 Secretary of Revenue or the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board to  
14 transfer any money within or between the appropriations in Part  
15 III.

16 Section 502. Effective date.--This act shall take effect  
17 July 1, 2010, or immediately, whichever is later.
