Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further 5 providing for costs of tuition and maintenance of certain exceptional children in approved institutions. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1376 of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 12 amended July 4, 2004 (P.L.536, No.70), is amended by adding a 13 subsection to read: 14 Section 1376. Cost of Tuition and Maintenance of Certain 15 Exceptional Children in Approved Institutions. --* * * 16 (c.9) The Department of Eduction shall approve an 17 application to be an approved private school if the applicant: 18 (1) Is an auditory-oral school for the deaf. (2) Is a member of the national organization of schools that 19

- 7 examined by the Alexander Graham Bell Association for the Deaf.

- 9 Section 2. Any and all regulations are abrogated to the
- 10 extent of any inconsistency with this act.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
