6	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has demonstrated its commitment
7	through various programs, including the Pennsylvania Adoption
8	Exchange, the Statewide Adoption and Permanency Network (SWAN),

10	hotline 1-800-585-SWAN; and
11	WHEREAS, Since the inception of SWAN in 1992, more than
12	21,000 children have been adopted from the Pennsylvania child

2 WHEREAS, Despite these many successes, there remains a need 3 for safe, permanent and loving homes; and

WHEREAS, The many caring families who have provided improved,
more stable lives to children through adoption deserve to be
recognized and honored; and
