## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the heroism of Philadelphia Police Sergeant Stephen
- Liczbinski, who, while in the service of the City of Philadelphia, paid the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty

- on May 3, 2008, when he was tragically killed while pursuing
- bank robbers.
- 6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Stephen Liczbinski, 39, served the City of
- 7 Philadelphia as an officer with the Philadelphia Police
- 8 Department for 12 years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, On the morning of May 3, 2008, Sgt. Liczbinski
- 10 responded to a bank robbery call, encountered the suspects in
- their getaway car, stopped their car at the intersection of 11
- Schiller and Almond Streets and, as he exited his patrol car, 12

- 1 was shot several times by one of the suspects; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In the chaos that immediately followed the gunshots,
- 3 residents of the Port Richmond neighborhood rushed to help the
- 4 fallen officer, radioing for an ambulance, wrapping his wounds
- 5 with towels to try to stop the bleeding, remembering his last
- 6 words before he fell unconscious, and helping to carry him to a
- 7 nearby patrol car that rushed him to a local hospital, where he
- 8 died from his wounds; and
- 9 WHEREAS, One suspect fled from the crash scene and was
- 10 arrested the next day, a second was shot and killed near the
- 11 crash scene by responding K-9 officers and the third is in
- 12 custody; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Sgt. Liczbinski was recognized throughout his unit
- 14 as a "cop's cop," because he always did more than was required,
- 15 and as his district sergeant said, he was "someone willing to do
- 16 the job above and beyond duty"; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Not only was Sgt. Liczbinski respected by his fellow
- 18 police officers, he was also a beloved member of the police
- 19 force, and his death has left many in the force deeply saddened;
- 20 and
- 21 WHEREAS, In tribute to his heroic service, Sqt. Liczbinski's
- 22 police badge No. 468 has been retired; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Sgt. Liczbinski's last words were "tell my wife I
- 24 love her"; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Sgt. Liczbinski, a resident of the Burholme section
- 26 of Philadelphia, always demonstrated great love for his family,
- 27 his "number one priority"; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Sgt. Liczbinski is survived by his wife Michele, his
- 29 children Matt, Steve and Amber, his daughter-in-law Bridget, and
- 30 his first grandchild and namesake, Stephen, who was born in

- 1 June; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The entire Commonwealth joins with the family of
- 3 Sgt. Liczbinski and with the members of his police department in
- 4 mourning the tragic death of this outstanding police officer;
- 5 therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 7 heroism of Philadelphia Police Sergeant Stephen Liczbinski, who,
- 8 while in the service of the City of Philadelphia, paid the
- 9 ultimate sacrifice on May 3, 2008, when he was tragically killed
- 10 while in pursuit of bank robbers.
