## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 7 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 commissions shall be determined," removing references to the Board of Trustees of Harrisburg State HospitalCERTAIN BOARDS 20 21 22 OF TRUSTEES.

23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

24 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 401 of the act, amended November 26, 1997 (P.L.530, No.57), is amended to read: 20 21 Section 401. Boards of Trustees of State Institutions.--(a) The boards of trustees of each of the State institutions 22 23 hereinafter mentioned shall consist of nine members, and the 24 head of the department having supervision over the institution ex officio. 25 26 The terms of each member of each such board shall be six (b) 27 years, and until his successor is appointed and qualified. 28 (c) All members of all boards, appointed to succeed members 29 who have served six year terms, shall be appointed for terms of 30 six years from the date of the expiration of the preceding term.

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Vacancies happening before the expiration of a term shall be
filled for the unexpired term.

3 (d) Five members of any such board shall constitute a4 quorum.

5 (e) Each such board shall annually elect a president and 6 vice-president from among its members, and a secretary and 7 treasurer who need not be members of the board. The secretary 8 and treasurer may be the same person.
