Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in education empowerment, further providing for MANDATE WAIVER PROGRAM AND FOR expiration. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1716 B of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L. 30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added May 10 11 10, 2000 (P.L.44, No.16), is repealed: 12 SECTION 1. SECTION 1714-B OF THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949, IS 13 14 AMENDED BY ADDING A SUBSECTION TO READ: 15 SECTION 1714-B. MANDATE WAIVER PROGRAM. --* * * 16 (D.1) (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY GRANT A WAIVER OF SECTION 751 17 WHERE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT INDICATES IN ITS APPLICATION THAT IT 18 INTENDS TO SOLICIT MULTIPLE PRIME AND SINGLE PRIME CONSTRUCTION BIDS AND AWARD THE CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER.

- 1 (2) FAILURE TO SOLICIT MULTIPLE PRIME AND SINGLE PRIME
- 2 CONSTRUCTION BIDS AND AWARD THE CONTRACT TO THE LOWEST
- 3 RESPONSIBLE BIDDER SHALL RESULT IN THE REVOCATION OF THE WAIVER.
- 4 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (D), FAILURE BY THE
- 5 DEPARTMENT TO ACT WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED TIME PERIOD SHALL NOT
- 6 CONSTITUTE AN APPROVAL OF A WAIVER OF SECTION 751.

- 9 (P.L.44, NO.16), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 11 1714-B AND 1715-B, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS article shall expire

- 13 Section $\frac{2}{3}$. This act shall take effect immediately.
