## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of 2 robbery. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3701 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 3701. Robberv. 9 Offense defined. --(a) 10 A person is guilty of robbery if, in the course of committing a theft, he: 11 12 (i) inflicts serious bodily injury upon another; (ii) 13 threatens another with or intentionally puts 14 him in fear of immediate serious bodily injury; 15 (iii) commits or threatens immediately to commit any 16 felony of the first or second degree; 17 inflicts bodily injury upon another or

1	threatens another with or intentionally puts him in fear
2	of immediate bodily injury; [or]
3	(v) physically takes or removes property from the
4	person of another by force however slight[.]; or
5	(vi) takes or removes the money of a financial
6	institution without the permission of the financial
7	institution by making a demand of an employee of the
8	financial institution orally or in writing with the
9	intent to deprive the financial institution thereof.
10	(2) An act shall be deemed "in the course of committing
11	a theft" if it occurs in an attempt to commit theft or in
12	flight after the attempt or commission.
13	(3) For purposes of this subsection, a "financial
14	institution" means a bank, trust company, savings trust,
15	credit union or similar institution.
16	(b) GradingRobbery under subsection (a)(1)(iv) and (vi)
17	is a felony of the second degree; robbery under subsection (a)
18	(1)(v) is a felony of the third degree; otherwise, it is a
19	felony of the first degree.
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
