1 2	Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for additional public meeting procedures.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Title 4 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
6	is amended by adding a section to read:
7	§ 1202.2. Additional public meeting procedures.
8	In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating
9	to open meetings), the board shall, prior to taking official
10	action, provide a reasonable opportunity at each advertised
11	regular meeting and advertised special or emergency meeting for
12	Commonwealth residents to comment on matters of concern or on
13	official action or deliberation on issues which are or may be
14	before the board. The board has the option to accept all public
15	comment at the beginning of the meeting. If the board determines
16	that there is not sufficient time at a meeting for residents of
17	the Commonwealth to comment, the board may defer the comment

- 1 period to the next regular meeting or to a special meeting
- 2 <u>occurring in advance of the next regular meeting. The board may,</u>
- 3 <u>in its discretion, set reasonable time limits on an individual's</u>
- 4 <u>comments.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
