5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 9720.3. Sentencing for persons convicted of three or more
9	<u>offenses.</u>
10	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who is
11	convicted of three or more violations of 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to
12	crimes and offenses) shall be sentenced to the maximum penalty
13	<u>available.</u>
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
