5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Washington County.
8	(a) AuthorizationThe Department of General Services, with
9	the approval of the Governor, is authorized on behalf of the
10	Commonwealth, to grant and convey to Washington County Authority
11	three tracts of land situate in Cecil Township, Washington
12	County, under terms and conditions to be established in an
13	Agreement of Sale with the Department of General Services.
14	(b) DescriptionThe property to be conveyed pursuant to
15	this section consists of three parcels of vacant land containing
16	67.875 acres, being bounded and more particularly described as
17	follows:

19	ALL THAT CERTAIN PARCEL of land situate in Cecil Township,

Washington County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania being South of 1 2 the Southpointe Exit on Interstate 79 (SR 79) and beginning on 3 the right-of-way along said interstate highway, being more particularly described as follows: 4

BEING designated as Tract 4, and described in accordance with a survey performed by Widmer Engineering, Inc., in September of 24 2008, last revised January 20, 2009.

(c) Reservation.--To effectuate this section, the department is authorized, on behalf of the Commonwealth, to reserve or grant any easements on property known as the Department of Transportation's Washington County Maintenance Facility, as the Secretary of General Services determines are appropriate or desirable, including for access and utility service.

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1 (d) Conditions.--

2 The conveyance shall be made under and subject to (1)3 all lawful and enforceable easements, servitudes and rights of others, including streets, roadways and rights of any 4 5 telephone, telegraph, water, electric, gas or pipeline 6 companies, and under and subject to any lawful and 7 enforceable estates or tenancies vested in third persons 8 appearing of record, for any portion of the land or 9 improvements erected on the land.

10 The conveyance shall be made under and subject to (2)the condition, which must be contained in the deed of 11 12 conveyance, that no portion of the property conveyed shall be 13 used as a licensed facility, as defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 14 (relating to definitions), or any other similar type of 15 facility authorized under State law. The condition shall be a 16 covenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the 17 grantee, its successors and assigns. If the grantee, its 18 successors or assigns permits any portion of the property 19 authorized to be conveyed in this act to be used in violation 20 of this subsection, the title shall immediately revert to and 21 revest in the grantor.

(e) Deed.--The deed of conveyance must be by special
warranty deed and must be executed by the secretary in the name
of the Commonwealth.

25 (f) Costs and fees.--Costs and fees incidental to the 26 conveyance shall be borne by the grantee.

(g) Expiration.--If an agreement of sale between the parties is not executed within 12 months of the effective date of this section, the authorization contained in this section shall expire.

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
