7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1073(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
10	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
11	amended January 16, 1974 (P.L.1, No.1), is amended and the
12	section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
13	Section 1073. Manner of Election or Approval* * *
14	(b) [At] Except as provided in subsection (b.1), at a
15	regular meeting of the board of school directors occurring at
16	least one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the expiration date
17	of the term of office of the district superintendent, the agenda
18	shall include an item requiring affirmative action by five or
19	more members of the board of school directors to notify the
20	district superintendent that the board intends to retain him for

a further term of from three (3) to five (5) years or that 1 another or other candidates will be considered for the office. 2 In the event that the board fails to take such action at a 3 regular meeting of the board of school directors occurring at 4 least one hundred fifty (150) days prior to the expiration date 5 of the term of office of the district superintendent, he shall 6 7 continue in office for a further term of similar length to that 8 which he is serving.

9 (b.1) Notwithstanding subsection (b), where three or more

10 incumbent school directors have been defeated in the primary

11 election and the contract of the district superintendent has

12 eleven (11) or more months remaining, the board shall be

13 prohibited from taking any action on the district

14 superintendent's contract until the new board of school

15 <u>directors has taken office.</u>

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
