1 2 3 4	Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," providing for violation exceptions for personal care homes.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as
8	the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>Section 1085.1. Violation Exceptions(a) Notwithstanding</u>
10	any other statutory or regulatory provision, no personal care
11	home shall be cited with a violation for not evacuating a
12	resident during a fire drill when:
13	(1) the resident is being treated and cared for by a
14	licensed hospice provider;
15	(2) a licensed clinician has made a determination that the
16	resident may suffer bodily injury as a result of participation
17	in a fire drill or that participating in a fire drill may
18	accelerate or hasten the death of the resident; and

1 (3) the resident, or the resident's power of attorney, has

2 <u>signed a written waiver directing that the resident is not to be</u>
3 evacuated during a fire drill.

- 4 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed as relieving
- 5 the personal care home of responsibility to provide necessary
- 6 intervention for the evacuation of any resident in the event of
- 7 <u>an actual emergency.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
