AN ACT

Designating the bridge in the Borough of Somerset over Barclay 1 Run as the Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge. 2 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 4 5 Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge. Section 1. Declaration. -- The General Assembly declares that Trooper 6 (a) 7 Stephen R. Gyurke made the ultimate sacrifice for this 8 Commonwealth on August 21, 1951, while serving in the-9 Pennsylvania State Police Troop B 2 when he was killed while in-10 performance of his duties AUGUST 24, 1958, WHEN HE DIED OF INJURIES SUFFERED WHILE PERFORMING HIS DUTIES. TROOPER GYURKE 11 12 WAS ASSIGNED TO THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE TROOP B-2 WHEN ON 13 AUGUST 21, 1958, HE SUFFERED SEVERE INJURIES THAT WOULD EVENTUALLY LEAD TO HIS DEATH DURING A TRAFFIC STOP on the 14 15 Pennsylvania Turnpike in Westmoreland County. 16 (b) Designation .-- The bridge over Barclay Run in the Borough 17 of Somerset is designated as the Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke 18 Memorial Bridge.

1 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall place and 2 maintain appropriate signs at both ends of the bridge designated 3 in subsection (b).

- 4 Section 2. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
