AN ACT

Amending the act of April 27, 1966 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.31, No.1), 1 entitled, as amended, "An act to protect the public health, welfare and safety by regulating the mining of bituminous 2 3 coal; declaring the existence of a public interest in the 4 support of surface structures; providing a remedy for the 5 restoration or replacement of water supplies affected by 6 underground mining; providing a remedy for the restoration or 7 replacement or compensation for surface structures damaged by 8 underground mining; providing standards for the prevention of 9 hazards to human safety and material damage to certain 10 structures; requiring permits, and in certain circumstances 11 bonds, for the mining of bituminous coal; providing for the 12 filing of maps or plans with recorders of deeds; providing for the giving of notice of mining operations to political 13 14 subdivisions and surface landowners of record; requiring mine 15 inspectors to accompany municipal officers and their agents 16 on inspection trips; granting powers to public officers and 17 affected property owners to enforce the act; requiring 18 grantors to certify as to whether any structures on the lands 19 conveyed are entitled to support from the underlying coal and 20 grantees to sign an admission of a warning of the possible 21 lack of any such right of support; requiring grantors to 22 provide notice of the existence of voluntary agreements for 23 24 the restoration or replacement of water supplies or for the 25 repair or compensation for structural damage; imposing duties on the Department of Environmental Resources for the 26 compilation and analysis of data; and imposing liability for 27 violation of the act," further providing for fees. 28

29 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

30 hereby enacts as follows:

31 Section 1. Section 5(h) of the act of April 27, 1966 (1st

Sp.Sess., P.L.31, No.1), known as The Bituminous Mine Subsidence
and Land Conservation Act, amended October 10, 1980 (P.L.874,
No.156), is amended to read:

Section 5. Permit; application; map or plan; bond or other security; filing; general rulemaking authority; prevention of damage; mine stability; maintenance of use and value of lands.--7 * * *

8 (h) The department is authorized to charge and collect from 9 persons in accordance with rules and regulations reasonable 10 filing fees for applications filed. <u>Such fees may be adjusted</u> 11 from time to time by regulations promulgated by the

12 Environmental Quality Board.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
