AN ACT
Amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for health insurance coverage not required.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 40 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 102. Health insurance coverage not required.
(a) General.--No resident of this Commonwealth, regardless of whether he has or is eligible for health insurance coverage under any policy or program provided by or through his employer, or a plan sponsored by the Federal Government or the Commonwealth, shall be required to obtain or maintain a policy of individual insurance coverage except as required by a court or the Department of Public Welfare where an individual is named a party in a judicial or administrative proceeding. No provision of any law shall render a resident of this Commonwealth liable for any penalty, assessment, fee or fine as a result of his
failure to procure or obtain health insurance coverage.
(b) Applicability.--This section shall not apply to:
(1) Individuals voluntarily applying for coverage under
a State-administered program under Title XIX or XXI of the
Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. S 301 et seq.).
(2) Students being required by an institution of higher
education to obtain and maintain health insurance as a
condition of enrollment.
(c) Rights.--Nothing in this section shall impair the rights
of persons to privately contract for health insurance for family
members or former family members.
Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
