## A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of May 6 through 12, 2010, as "Nurses Week"
in Pennsylvania.
WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association, which includes 24 organizational affiliates and is the largest professional nursing association in this Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association has advanced the identity, integrity and the continuity of the profession of nursing in this Commonwealth for more than 105 years; and

WHEREAS, "National Nurses Week," with the theme "Nurses: Caring Today for a Healthier Tomorrow," begins May 6 and ends May 12, in conjunction with Florence Nightingale's birthday; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has nearly 206,000 registered nurses, including nearly 11,000 advanced practice nurses; and

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association is working diligently to chart a new course for a healthy Commonwealth that
relies on increasing the delivery of primary and preventative health care, coupled with a strong focus on nursing care; and WHEREAS, Nursing care provided by the registered nurses of this Commonwealth is a paramount component to Pennsylvania's health care delivery system; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of May 6 through 12, 2010, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further RESOLVED, That the Senate join the Pennsylvania State Nurses Association and other nursing organizations in recognizing the selfless service of Pennsylvania's nurses and the overall importance of quality nursing care.
