- 3 WHEREAS, Each May, Americans mark Memorial Day to grieve the
- 4 loss of soldiers, airmen, sailors and marines who were killed in
- 5 battle and to celebrate the freedoms and rights they gained for
- 6 us through their sacrifices; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Since 1776, the roll call of the fallen heroes has
- 8 climbed to well over one million people; and
- 9 WHEREAS, When it comes to military service, this Commonwealth
- 10 has given more than its share in sweat and blood; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The willingness of the men and women of this
- 12 Commonwealth to answer the call to duty is made clear by the
- 13 number of veterans living in communities across Pennsylvania;

- 15 WHEREAS, It is proper to recognize and honor these American
- 16 patriots who put their lives on the line to win this nation's

- 2 who fought one another over the struggle for liberty and freedom
- 3 during the Civil War, and the hundreds of thousands of brave men
- 4 and women who fought to defend our freedom all over the world
