A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Local Government Commission on its 75th
2 anniversary.

3 WHEREAS, The Local Government Commission is marking its 75th
4 anniversary; and

5 WHEREAS, The commission, created by the act of May 29, 1935
6 (P.L.244, No.102), referred to as the Local Government
7 Commission Law, is a bipartisan legislative service agency the
8 primary mission of which is to advise the General Assembly on
9 matters directly related to the operation and function of
10 municipal government in this Commonwealth; and

11 WHEREAS, The commission is one of the oldest agencies of its
12 kind in the United States; and

13 WHEREAS, The commission, comprised of five Senators and five
14 members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the
15 President pro tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of
16 Representatives, respectively, has become the major resource for
17 legislators who need various types of assistance in the field of
18 local government; therefore be it

1 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
2 General Assembly extend hearty congratulations, pay tribute to
3 the Local Government Commission, its members and staff, on the
4 momentous occasion of 75 years of excellence and exceptional
5 service and offer its best wishes for many more years of success
6 during which the commission will continue to help improve and
7 strengthen local government in this Commonwealth; and be it
