AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the registered gross weight limit of certain registration plates.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Sections 1307(a.1), 1338(a)(9), 1341, 1342(a),
7	(c) and (d), 1346, 1348, 1350, 1350.1, 1351, 1352, 1353,
8	1354(a), 1355, 1356, 1357, 1358, 1359(a), 1360, 1362, 1363, 1364
9	and 1365(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
10	Statutes are amended to read:
11	§ 1307. Period of registration.
12	* * *
13	(a.1) Seasonal registrationUpon application on a form
14	prescribed by the department, the owner or lessee of a passenger
15	car, recreational motor vehicle, motorcycle, truck or farm
16	vehicle which does not have a gross vehicle weight rating of
17	more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds may register the vehicle with
18	the department for a period of successive months of less than

one year. The applicant shall specify the period of months 1 2 during which the vehicle shall be registered. Except when the 3 department initially converts a currently valid annual registration to a seasonal registration, the annual fee 4 prescribed for the vehicle by Chapter 19 (relating to fees) 5 6 shall be paid in full by the applicant regardless of the number of months chosen for registration by the applicant. Upon receipt 7 8 of the appropriate fee and the properly completed form, including all information required by this chapter, the 9 10 department shall issue a seasonal registration that shall expire 11 on the last day of the expiration month chosen by the 12 registrant. No insurer of a vehicle belonging to any owner or 13 lessee who obtains a seasonal registration and who applies for 14 or receives a reduced automobile insurance premium on account 15 thereof shall be required to provide any contractual coverage, 16 whether in the form of the provision of a defense or the payment of first-party or third-party benefits or otherwise, to the 17 18 owner or lessee in connection with any event occurring during 19 that part of the year in which the vehicle is not registered; 20 and such owner or lessee shall be treated for all purposes, 21 including, without limitation, ascertaining rights to stack coverages and to uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage, 22 23 as a person who does not own that vehicle and has no duty to 24 carry financial responsibility on it for that part of the year. 25 * * *

26 § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard.

(a) Person with disability plate.--On the application of anyperson who:

30 (9) is a person in loco parentis of a person specified 20110HB0156PN0093 - 2 -

1 in paragraph (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) or (8); 2 the department shall issue a special registration plate for one 3 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds, designating the vehicle so 4 licensed as being used by a person with a disability. Special 5 plates for persons with disabilities may also be issued for 6 vehicles operated exclusively for the use and benefit of persons 7 8 with disabilities. In the case of a motorcycle, the department 9 shall issue a decal containing the international symbol for 10 access for persons with disabilities for display on the registration plate. 11

13 § 1341. Special registration plates generally.

14 Upon request by the applicant, the department may issue 15 registration plates consisting of any combination of numbers, 16 letters or numbers and letters. These special plates may be 17 issued for special groups or for special purposes and bear an 18 appropriate designation. Special groups may charge a fee for 19 authorization to request a registration plate bearing the name 20 of the group. They shall have the same force and effect as 21 regular registration plates. The department may refuse any 22 combination of letters and numbers for cause and shall adopt 23 reasonable rules and regulations for the issuance of the plates 24 and for carrying out the provisions of this section. The 25 applicant shall comply with all laws and regulations pertaining 26 to registration including the payment of any additional fees. 27 The department is authorized to reissue a combination of numbers 28 or letters for a personal plate if the department records reveal 29 that no activity, such as renewal or transfer of the personal 30 registration plate, has occurred for a period of five or more

consecutive years and provided that the personal registration 1 2 plate was never reported as lost or stolen. Whenever the 3 department reissues an inactive personal plate, the department may purge its records of all references to the previous owners 4 5 of that personal plate. The department shall, however, note upon its records the reissuance of the personal plate and to whom the 6 plate was issued. The special registration plate may be used 7 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight 8 of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. If the vehicle is 9 10 licensed to a business that is not a member of the special group, the department shall issue the plate as long as the 11 business owner or officer making application is a member of that 12 13 group.

14 § 1342. Veteran plates and placard.

15 Severely disabled veteran plate. -- On the application of (a) 16 a veteran whose service-connected disability is certified at 100% by the service unit of the armed forces in which the 17 18 veteran served or by the United States Veterans' Administration 19 or who has a service-connected disability of the type enumerated in section 1338 (relating to person with disability plate and 20 placard), the department shall issue a special registration 21 plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a severely 22 23 disabled veteran. The registration plate shall have a white 24 background, shall have blue numbers or letters as the department may determine, shall have the words "disabled veteran" in at 25 26 least ten-point bold type inscribed in red at the bottom of the 27 plate and shall include the international symbol for access for 28 persons with disabilities. Only one special registration plate 29 shall be issued to a veteran under this section. It may be used 30 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight

1 of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. In the case of a 2 motorcycle, the department shall issue a decal containing the 3 international symbol for access for persons with disabilities 4 and the words "disabled veteran" for display on the registration 5 plate.

6 * * *

7 (c) Disabled veteran plates. -- On the application of any 8 veteran having a disability certified by the service unit of the 9 armed forces in which the veteran served or by the United States 10 Veterans' Administration as service-connected, the department shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle 11 as belonging to a disabled veteran. The registration plate shall 12 have a white background, shall have numbers or letters as the 13 department may determine and shall have the words "disabled 14 15 veteran" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed at the bottom 16 of the plate. Only one special registration plate shall be issued to a veteran under this section. It may be used only on a 17 18 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not 19 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

20 Prisoner of war plate. -- On the application of an ex-(d) prisoner of war whose imprisonment while in the service of the 21 armed forces of the United States is certified by the 22 23 appropriate branch of the armed forces, the department shall 24 issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle as 25 belonging to an ex-prisoner of war. The registration plate shall 26 contain the letters "POW" and such other numbers or letters as the department may determine and shall have the words "prisoner 27 28 of war" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed at the bottom 29 of the plate. Only one special registration plate shall be 30 issued to an ex-prisoner of war under this subsection. The

special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car
 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than
 [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

§ 1346. Special plates for recipients of Purple Heart. 5 6 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the 7 Purple Heart, the department shall issue to such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed 8 as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Purple Heart. 9 10 A severely disabled veteran, as described in section 1342(a) 11 (relating to veteran plates and placard), who is qualified to receive a plate under this section may also elect to receive a 12 13 placard under section 1342(b). The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered 14 15 gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds. 16 § 1348. Special plates for Pearl Harbor survivors.

17 Upon application of any person who is a survivor of Pearl 18 Harbor, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition 19 to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the 20 department shall require, the department shall issue to such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so 21 licensed as belonging to a person who is a survivor of Pearl 22 23 Harbor. The special registration plate may be used only on a 24 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not 25 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

26 § 1350. Special plates for veterans of Korean War.

27 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the Korean 28 War, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which shall be in addition to 29 the annual registration fee, and by such documentation as the 30 department shall require, the department shall issue to the

1 person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so
2 licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of the Korean
3 War. The special registration plate may be used only on a
4 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
5 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

6 § 1350.1. Special plates for recipients of Korean Defense7 Service Medal.

8 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which 9 10 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department 11 shall issue to the person a special registration plate 12 13 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 14 is a recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal. The 15 department shall design and produce the special registration 16 plate. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not 17 18 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

19 § 1351. Special plates for veterans of Persian Gulf War. 20 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the Persian Gulf War, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which shall be in 21 addition to the annual registration fee, and by such 22 23 documentation as the department shall require, the department 24 shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 25 26 is a veteran of the Persian Gulf War. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a 27 28 registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 29 § 1352. Wild resource conservation plate.

30 The department, in consultation with the Wild Resource

Conservation Board, shall design a special wild resource 1 2 conservation registration plate. Upon application of any person, 3 accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate 4 for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a 5 registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 6 The Wild Resource Conservation Fund shall receive \$15 of each 7 8 additional fee for this plate.

9 § 1353. Preserve our heritage registration plate.

10 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, shall design a special 11 preserve our heritage registration plate. Upon receipt of an 12 13 application, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in 14 addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall 15 issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or 16 truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds. The Historical Preservation Fund shall receive 17 18 \$15 of each additional fee for this plate.

19 § 1354. Flagship Niagara commemorative registration plate. 20 (a) Plate.--The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, shall design a 21 Flagship Niagara commemorative registration plate. Upon 22 23 application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which 24 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the 25 department shall issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not 26 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 27

29 § 1355. Zoological plate.

30 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania 20110HB0156PN0093 - 8 -

1 Zoological Council, shall design a special zoological 2 registration plate. Upon application of any person, accompanied 3 by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a 4 passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a registered 5 gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. The 6 Zoological Enhancement Fund shall receive \$15 of the fee paid by 7 8 the applicant for the plate.

9 § 1356. Special plates for recipients of Expeditionary Forces10 Medal.

11 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Expeditionary Forces Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which 12 13 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such 14 documentation as the department shall require, the department 15 shall issue to such person a special registration plate 16 designating the vehicle so registered as belonging to a person 17 who is a recipient of the Expeditionary Forces Medal. The 18 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car 19 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 20

21 § 1357. Special plates for World War II veterans.

22 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of World War 23 II, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to 24 the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the 25 department shall require, the department shall issue to such 26 person a special registration plate carrying the symbol of a 27 ruptured duck designating the vehicle so registered as belonging 28 to a person who is a veteran of World War II. The special 29 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 30

1 pounds.

2 § 1358. DARE plate.

3 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency, shall design a special drug 4 abuse resistance education (DARE) registration plate which 5 utilizes the DARE logo or slogan in the design. Upon application 6 of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in 7 addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall 8 9 issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or 10 truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds. The Drug Abuse Resistance Education Program shall 11 receive \$15 of each additional fee for this plate. 12

13 § 1359. Special plates for steelworkers.

14 (a) General rule.--Upon application of any person who is a 15 steelworker, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in 16 addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department 17 18 shall issue to such person a special registration plate 19 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 20 is a steelworker. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or a truck with a registered gross 21 weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. The plate shall 22 23 bear the likeness of the official emblem of the American Iron 24 and Steel Institute.

26 § 1360. Special plates for veterans of Vietnam Conflict.

27 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the 28 Vietnam Conflict as that term is defined for the awarding of the 29 Vietnam Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 in addition 30 to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the

department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of the Vietnam Conflict. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

7 § 1362. Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans plate.

8 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the liberation or occupation of Iraq, accompanied by a fee of \$20 9 10 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by documentation as the department shall require, the department 11 shall issue to the person a special registration plate 12 13 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 14 is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The special 15 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 16 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 17 pounds.

18 § 1363. Operation Enduring Freedom veterans plate.

19 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the 20 liberation or occupation of Afghanistan, accompanied by a fee of 21 \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by documentation as the department shall require, the 22 23 department shall issue to the person a special registration 24 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a 25 person who is a veteran of Operation Enduring Freedom. The 26 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 27 [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 28

29 § 1364. Special plates for veterans.

30 Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged

veteran of the armed forces of the United States or a reserve 1 2 component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301 3 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such 4 5 documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate 6 designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a 7 8 veteran of the armed forces of the United States. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 9 10 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000_ 11 pounds.

12 § 1365. Gold Star Family plate.

13 General rule.--Upon application of a family member of a (a) 14 person who was killed while serving on active duty in the 15 military, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition 16 to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the 17 18 family member a special registration plate designating the 19 vehicle so licensed as belonging to a family member of a person 20 who was killed while serving on active duty in the military. The department shall design and produce the special registration 21 plate carrying the Service Flag Gold Star rimmed with blue which 22 23 represents sacrifice to the cause of liberty and freedom. The 24 words "Gold Star Family" shall be clearly displayed along the 25 bottom of the plate. The special registration plate may be used 26 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 27
