AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 26 (Eminent Domain) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in just compensation and measure of
- damages, further providing for the reimbursement of
- appraisal, attorney and engineering fees.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 710(a) of Title 26 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 710. Limited reimbursement of appraisal, attorney and
- 10 engineering fees.
- 11 (a) General rule. -- The owner of any right, title or interest
- 12 in real property acquired or injured by an acquiring agency, who
- 13 is not eligible for reimbursement of fees under section 306(q)
- 14 (relating to preliminary objections), 308(d) (relating to
- 15 revocation of condemnation proceedings) or 709 (relating to
- 16 condemnee's costs where no declaration of taking filed), shall
- 17 be reimbursed in an amount not to exceed [\$4,000] \$25,000 as a

- 1 payment toward reasonable expenses actually incurred for
- 2 appraisal, attorney and engineering fees.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
