## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the finances of the State 2 3 government; providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts 4 due the Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and 5 other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, 6 or any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 7 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 8 9 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims 10 against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 13 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 14 15 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 16 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 17 18 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 19 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 20 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 21 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 22 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 23 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, 24 association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 25 26 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 27 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 28 29 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth, " authorizing the State Treasurer to enter into 30 an agreement to set off Federal debt. 31

- 32 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 33 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
- 2 as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding a section to read:
- 3 Section 615. Agreement Authorized; Federal Debt Setoff. -- (a)
- 4 The State Treasurer is authorized to enter into an agreement
- 5 with the United States to participate in the Treasury Offset
- 6 Program pursuant to 31 U.S.C. § 3716 (relating to administrative
- 7 offset) for the collection of any debts owed to Commonwealth
- 8 agencies. The agreement may provide for the United States to
- 9 <u>submit debts owed to Federal agencies for offset against</u>
- 10 Commonwealth payments and provide for the Commonwealth to submit
- 11 <u>debts owed to Commonwealth agencies for offset against Federal</u>
- 12 payments.
- (b) The Treasurer of the United States shall reduce any
- 14 Commonwealth payment by the amount of any Federal debt submitted
- 15 in accordance with the agreement authorized by this section, and
- 16 pay such amount to the appropriate Federal official in
- 17 accordance with the procedures specified in the agreement.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
