4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1725.3(c) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1725.3. Criminal laboratory user fee.

10	(c) Disposition of fees
11	(1) In [a county of the first class or a county of the
12	second class] any county that operates a county laboratory,
13	the criminal laboratory user fee shall be paid to the county
14	and shall be used solely for operation and maintenance of the
15	county laboratory. If a county [of the first class or a
16	county of the second class] does not operate a county
17	laboratory, the criminal laboratory user fee shall be paid
18	into the Criminal Laboratory User Fee Fund created under

1 paragraph (2).

2 (2) In [a county other than a county of the first class or a county of the second class or where a county of the 3 first class or a county of the second class] any county that 4 5 does not operate a county laboratory, the criminal laboratory 6 user fee shall be paid into a special nonlapsing fund of the State Treasury, which is hereby established and shall be 7 8 known as the Criminal Laboratory User Fee Fund. Money in the 9 Criminal Laboratory User Fee Fund is hereby appropriated to 10 the Pennsylvania State Police and shall be used solely for operation and maintenance of Pennsylvania State Police 11 criminal laboratories. 12
